



Buckle Up!

San Bernardino County

The Traffic S.A.F.E. Program provides a **Violator Intervention Program (V.I.P.)** for persons who have been cited for non-use of child safety seats and seat belts and are referred by a court or law enforcement agency.

California law requires all children to be properly buckled up in a child safety seat from birth to 6 years of age, or 60 pounds of weight. Older children and adult passengers must be properly restrained in a seat belt each time they ride in a vehicle.

Classes are taught by certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians and provide instruction on the law, how safety restraints work to prevent injury in a crash, a video presentation and demonstrations on the proper use of safety restraints. Technicians also inspect car seats brought to the class to ensure that they meet safety regulations.

Important Registration Information:

- Classes are 3 hours in length. You must complete the entire class to receive a court certificate of completion.
- Classes are offered once a month in San Bernardino. Please call early to register.
- A \$50 class fee must be paid at the time of the class. **Cash only.**
- New car seats are available for purchase for the low cost of \$35 should your child need a car seat.
- Car seats that are too old, damaged, have missing parts, or have been in a car crash should be replaced.
