## **Cities That Have Adopted the Restaurant Grading County Ordinance**

Since the restaurant grading ordinance is a County regulation, it is effective only in unincorporated County areas. This means that it is mandatory that food facilities in unincorporated County areas post their letter grade for public view.

For restaurants located within city limits, posting of the letter grade is voluntary. In order for this regulation to be enforced within city limits, each city must adopt the County ordinance.

The following cities have adopted the restaurant grading ordinance:
