

Cities That Have Adopted the Restaurant Grading County Ordinance in San Bernardino County

The County of San Bernardino, Environmental Health Service inspects restaurants to ensure sanitation and food safety standards are met to protect the public’s health. When a restaurant is inspected, they receive a score and a letter grade according to their inspection report.

The restaurant grading ordinance in San Bernardino County is a regulation that requires restaurants to post their letter grades for public view. It is mandatory for all restaurants in unincorporated County areas to post their letter grade for public view. For restaurants located within city limits, posting of the letter grade is voluntary. In order for this regulation to be enforced within city limits, each city must adopt the County ordinance.

The following cities have adopted the restaurant grading ordinance:
