

**NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING FOR LAFCO 3086 –
REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE ANNEXATIONS TO CITY OF BARSTOW,
ODESSA WATER DISTRICT AND BARSTOW FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
AND DETACHMENT FROM THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
AND ITS NORTH DESERT SERVICE ZONE (07-02-RIMROCK ROAD)**

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of San Bernardino County. The hearing will be held in the LAFCO office located at 215 N. "D" St., Suite 204, San Bernardino, California 92415-0490, on December 11, 2008, at 2:00 p.m., to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3086.

The reorganization area encompasses approximately 645+/- acres and is generally bordered by Rimrock Road (existing City boundaries) on the north, parcel boundaries (existing City boundaries) on the east, parcel boundaries on the south, and the natural extension of Higgins Road (existing City boundaries) on the west. The area lies within the City's eastern sphere of influence.

Proceedings for this reorganization were initiated by the City of Barstow and submitted to LAFCO. This proposal has been assigned the short-form designation of LAFCO 3086.

The proposed terms and conditions for this reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3032 adopted by the Commission on October 15, 2008, which is available for review in the LAFCO office.

The reason for this proposal, as provided by the City, is:

The subject reorganization will regularize and "square up" a jog in the existing City boundary for an area which is bordered on three sides by the City. This would also facilitate development of an area served by the City.

Any owner of land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, address of the land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor Parcel Number and LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.
