

**NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING ON APRIL 27, 2010 FOR  
LAFCO 3100 – REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE ANNEXATION TO THE  
CITY OF VICTORVILLE AND VICTORVILLE WATER DISTRICT, AND  
DETACHMENT FROM SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION  
DISTRICT, ITS NORTH DESERT SERVICE ZONE, AND COUNTY  
SERVICE AREA 70 (SPACE CENTER MIRA LOMA)**

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of San Bernardino County. The hearing will be held at the LAFCO Office at 215 N. "D" St., Suite 204, San Bernardino, California 92415-0490, on April 27, 2010, at 2:00 p.m., to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3100.

The territory proposed for reorganization encompasses approximately 6.46+/- acres generally located south of Terra Linda Street within the City's unincorporated "Coad Road" island. The reorganization area, includes two (2) individual parcels, Assessor Parcel Numbers (APN) 3090-531-03 and 3090-531-04, and a portion of a railroad parcel, APN 3090-511-05, and is generally bordered by Terra Linda Street on the north, and parcel lines (existing City of Victorville boundaries) on the east, south and west. The portion to be detached from the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District and its North Desert Service Zone encompasses the railroad right-of-way of the reorganization area.

The reorganization area is more specifically described in the legal descriptions and maps which can be accessed below.

Proceedings for this reorganization were initiated by property owner petition and submitted to LAFCO. This proposal has been assigned the short-form designation of LAFCO 3100.

The proposed terms and conditions for this reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3070 adopted by the Commission on October 21, 2009 which is available for review in the LAFCO office.

The reason for this proposal, as provided by the applicant, is:

To receive municipal services from the City of Victorville and the Victorville Water District for a proposed industrial project.

Any owner of land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, address of the land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor Parcel Number and LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.
