

NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING

LAFCO 3168 – ACTIVATION OF SEWER POWERS FOR THE VICTORVILLE WATER DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of San Bernardino County for LAFCO 3168. The hearing will be held at the LAFCO Office at 215 N. "D" St., Suite 204, San Bernardino, California 92415-0490, on **December 21, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.**, to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3168.

The study area for activation of sewer power encompasses approximately 85 square miles and is generally described as being bordered by a combination of the City of Adelanto, the Mojave River, the Oro Grande community, and parcel lines on the north, by a combination of the Town of Apple Valley and Spring Valley Lake community on the east, the Hesperia Water District on the south, and a combination the City of Adelanto and Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District on the west.

Proceedings for this reorganization were initiated by the Victorville Water District and submitted to LAFCO. This proposal has been assigned the short-form designation of LAFCO 3168.

The proposed terms and conditions for this reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3151 adopted by the Commission on October 19, 2011, which is available for review in the LAFCO office.

The reason for this proposal, as outlined by the Victorville Water District, is to allow the District to provide for wastewater treatment, collection and transportation and to provide for the reuse of reclaimed water in the most cost effective manner.

Any owner of land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, address of the land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor Parcel Number and LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax or e-mail.

Any registered voter residing within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name and address as they appear on the affidavit of registration and the LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax or e-mail.
