SYNOPSIS:

On Saturday May 23, 2009 at approximately 1:49 am San Bernardino County Sheriff Deputies from the Chino Hills Station responded to a call of people fighting in the street in the 15200 block of Carmelita Avenue in the unincorporated area of Chino Hills. Callers indicated someone was run-over in the street by a dark colored van and a dark colored sedan, possibly a Toyota Camry. Upon arrival Deputies found Raymond Jimenez lying in the street unresponsive. Jimenez was transported to Chino Valley Medical Center where he was pronounced deceased at 2:35 am.

The San Bernardino County Sheriff's Specialized Investigations Detail responded and initiated a homicide investigation. Chino Hills Deputies located the dark colored van and it's occupants nearby who were found to be friends of the victim. Detectives have identified the second vehicle as a dark colored Toyota Camry driven by suspect #1, Daniel Guebara, 18 years old from Chino Hills and most recently Rancho Cucamonga. Guebara was with suspect #2, his father Paul Guebara. Both suspects may have been armed during the incident.
