SYNOPSIS:

On Sunday, May 31, 2009 at approximately 2:46 p.m., deputies responded to Nader's Liquor Store in Loma Linda following a 911 call that a robbery had just occurred. Deputies were advised by the victim that 3 black males had entered the store, armed with handguns and demanding money. The victim complied with their demands and was unharmed during the incident. The suspects fled the location with an undisclosed amount of money in a Pontiac Grand Am.

Through the investigation, detectives identified the vehicle that the suspects left the location in and later located that vehicle. The identification of that vehicle also led detectives to the identity and arrest of one of the suspects involved, Eron Jackson. Jackson was arrested on June 2, 2009 in Perris, CA. He is currently in custody at the Central Detention Center where he is being charged with felony armed robbery.

Detectives are asking for the public's assistance in identifying the two other suspects involved in this incident. Anyone with information regarding their identity and/or whereabouts is asked to contact Detective Ken Owens at Central Station (909) 387-3545.
