RESIDENTIAL ROBBERY **SUSPECTS WANTED**



The composite sketches depict the two assailants the victim saw. The HMA (S1, left) was seen at the front door and brandished the hand gun. The AMA (S2, right) entered the house behind S1 and assisted in restraining the victim. The victim believes S2 to be of Vietnamese descent. S1 was seen at the front door wearing a long, dark colored coat with shoulder patches. The victim believed S1 was a police officer. Neither suspect identified themselves as law enforcement.



On February 9, 2009 at approximately 3:00 p.m., deputies from the Chino Hills Police department responded to a residence in the 13500 block of Ravenna Court in Chino Hills reference the report of a residential robbery. The victim was alone at the time when an unknown Hispanic male knocked at the front door. The victim saw one subject through the window and believed him to be wearing a law enforcement type uniform. The suspect did not identify himself as a police officer. When the victim opened the door, one suspect pointed a gun at the victim and forced him back into the house where both suspects bound the victim at the hands and feet. Both suspects also assaulted the victim demanding property. Three other suspects also entered the house, ransacking the home for approximately 45 minutes to an hour. The suspects left the location with property leaving the victim tied up on the floor. The victim was found 5 hours later by the home owner when he returned home from work. Detectives from the Chino Hills Police/Sheriff's station are actively investigating the crime.
